Replacing playfields on other Tornado tables

As we try to explain, like the Ford Mustang, Dodge Charger or Chevrolet Malibu, many of the Tornado names have been used on vastly different products with few interchangeable parts. Your table might be a Storm, but not all Storms are the same. Playfield replacement on some tables is fairly simply done, on other tables the sad fact is you would need to destroy the table to such degree to access and remove the playfield that it could never be properly reassembled.



Realize that any playfield will cost several hundred dollars, and ships in a 70lb crate. Those several hundred dollars might be better spent toward a new table.

Imported tables from the latter days of Tornado's ownership by Brunswick (such as the Storm depicted at the left) are characterized by rounded legs, inset cupholders and flexible plastic internal ball return tubes.

Playfields on these tables cannot be replaced

On Tornado tables with SQUARE LEGS and plastic top corners like that shown at the lower right, the Playfield can usually be replaced, but we strongly urge you to <u>contact Valley Dynamo Tech Support</u> before proceeding. We may ask you to take a couple photos of the outside of your table and inside the goal entry (as shown) to make a determination. This will help us figure out the approximate age and design of your table.
